Student Programs

Jean Paul Gaultier express talk

Recommended for all levels

An illustrated, interactive talk exploring creative connections between art and fashion in the exhibition *The Fashion World of Jean Paul Gaultier*. Content will be tailored to the level of each student group.

Cost \$13 (30 mins)

Jean Paul Gaultier themes and inspiration

Recommended for Years 10–12 including VCE Art, VCE Studio Arts, Product Design and Technology and Visual Communication and Design students

An illustrated introduction to *The Fashion World of Jean Paul Gaultier* that highlights key themes in the exhibition, including the designer's sources of inspiration and artistic collaboration with photographers, filmmakers, choreographers, musicians, muses and artists.

The T-shirt workshop (1 hr)

The cape, the collar or the corset workshop (2 hrs)

Recommended for Years 4–10

Inspired by *The Fashion World of Jean Paul Gaultier*, design, create, construct and parade your own wearable art. Bring the camera! Please note that this program is designed to follow the Jean Paul Gaultier express talk program and self-guided viewing of the exhibitions.

Art and fashion – connections, traditions and innovations

Recommended for Years 10–12

Extend your understanding of the connections between art and fashion, and traditions and innovation in fashion design through an exploration of historical and contemporary works in the NGV Collection.

Recommended for Years 10–12

Tue 9 & Wed 10 Dec, 10am–4pm

Get inspired for 2015 with this intensive two-day program for senior students with an interest in textiles and fashion. Gain behind-the-scenes insights into the exhibition and the fashion world, and learn more about career paths in fashion. Program includes exhibition introduction and viewing, and sessions in the NGV Education studio exploring sources of inspiration and practical design processes and skills for developing folio work. Students will construct their own crinoline with which to create amazing costumes. Presenters include NGV curators and fashion industry experts.

An immersive and stimulating program designed to inspire and focus senior Art and Design students. Program will include workshops, discussions and study room and studio visits led by artists and NGV educators and curators.

Sessions will include a focus on key works in the NGV Collection and current exhibitions, including *The Fashion World of Jean Paul Gaultier*, *David Shrigley: Life and Life Drawing*, *Emily Floyd: The Dawn* and *Robert Jacks: Order and Variation*, as inspiration for research and practical work.

Program will include practical art-making workshops led by artists, designers and educators, and will support the development of teaching and learning activities related to current curriculum frameworks. Break-out sessions will focus on Primary and Secondary Art and specific disciplines and studies, including Art and Visual Communication in AusVELs and Art, Studio Arts, Visual Communication and Design, and Product Design and Technology in the VCE.
