
COLOUR FUNI


Get the facts

- When two primary colours are mixed together, they make a new colour called a secondary colour. Green, orange and purple are all secondary colours.




MIX IT UP Mix colours and draw the answers to the riddles.

What colour do you make by mixing red and yellow? I am a round fruit and the name of a colour.




What colour do you make when you mix yellow and blue? I am an amphibian and I can hop!

Mix red and blue together to make this colour. I am a vegetable – I am an egg and a plant!




Add white to a colour to to make it lighter.
