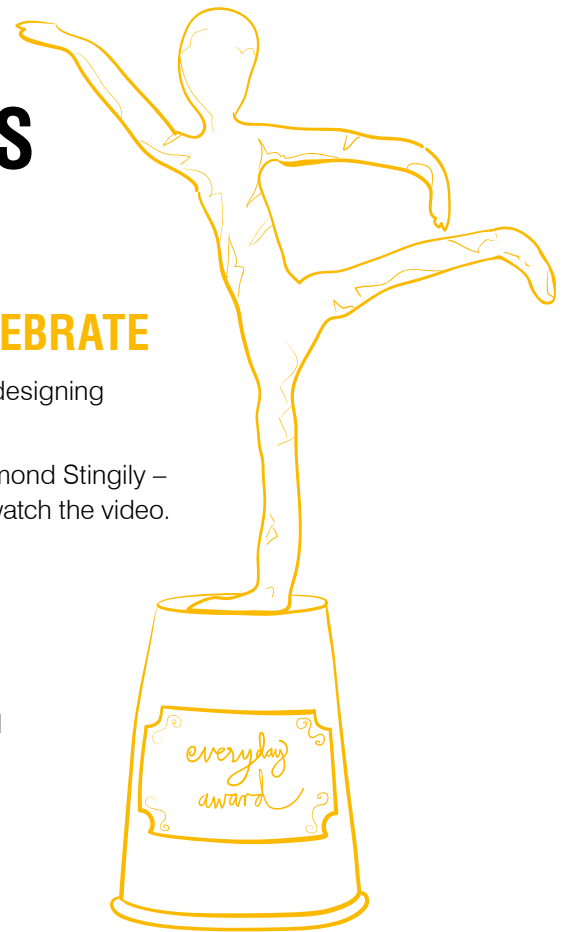
#### MATERIALS

- Pipe cleaners
- Aluminium foil
- Masking tape
- Gold, silver or bronze metallic paint
- Paper cups
- Trophy labels
- Grey lead pencil
- Paint brush
- Pen

#### HOW TO MAKE YOUR TROPHY

##### 1 Sketch

- What victory or achievement are you celebrating? Draw a figure for the top of your trophy to represent it. Use your imagination!





**2 Bend, fold & twist**  
Use pipe cleaners to create the outline of your figure.



**3 Frame it**  
Add more pipe cleaners to give your stick figure three-dimensional form.



**4 Add some volume**  
Use foil to add volume and padding to the figure.



**5 Position and tape**  
Move your figure into your desired posture and cover it with masking tape. Smooth down the edges.



**6 Paint**  
Gold, silver or bronze what will it be? Paint your figure and cup.

**7 Attach**  
Use masking tape to secure your figure to the cup base.

**8 Paint again**  
Apply your final coat of paint.



**9 Label**  
What is your trophy celebrating?  
Create a plaque and attach it to your trophy.
