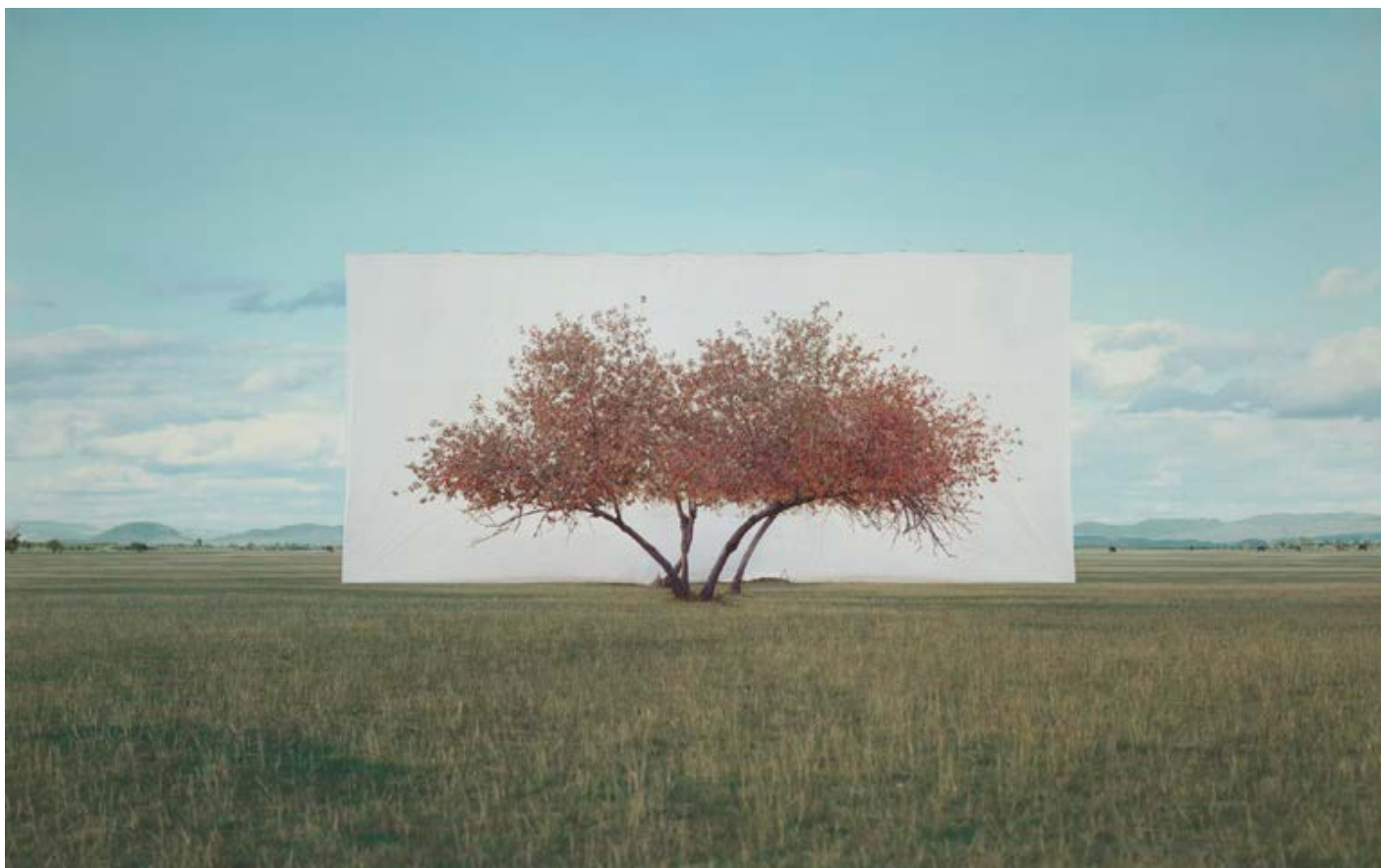


FAMILY TREES

National Gallery of Victoria, Melbourne.

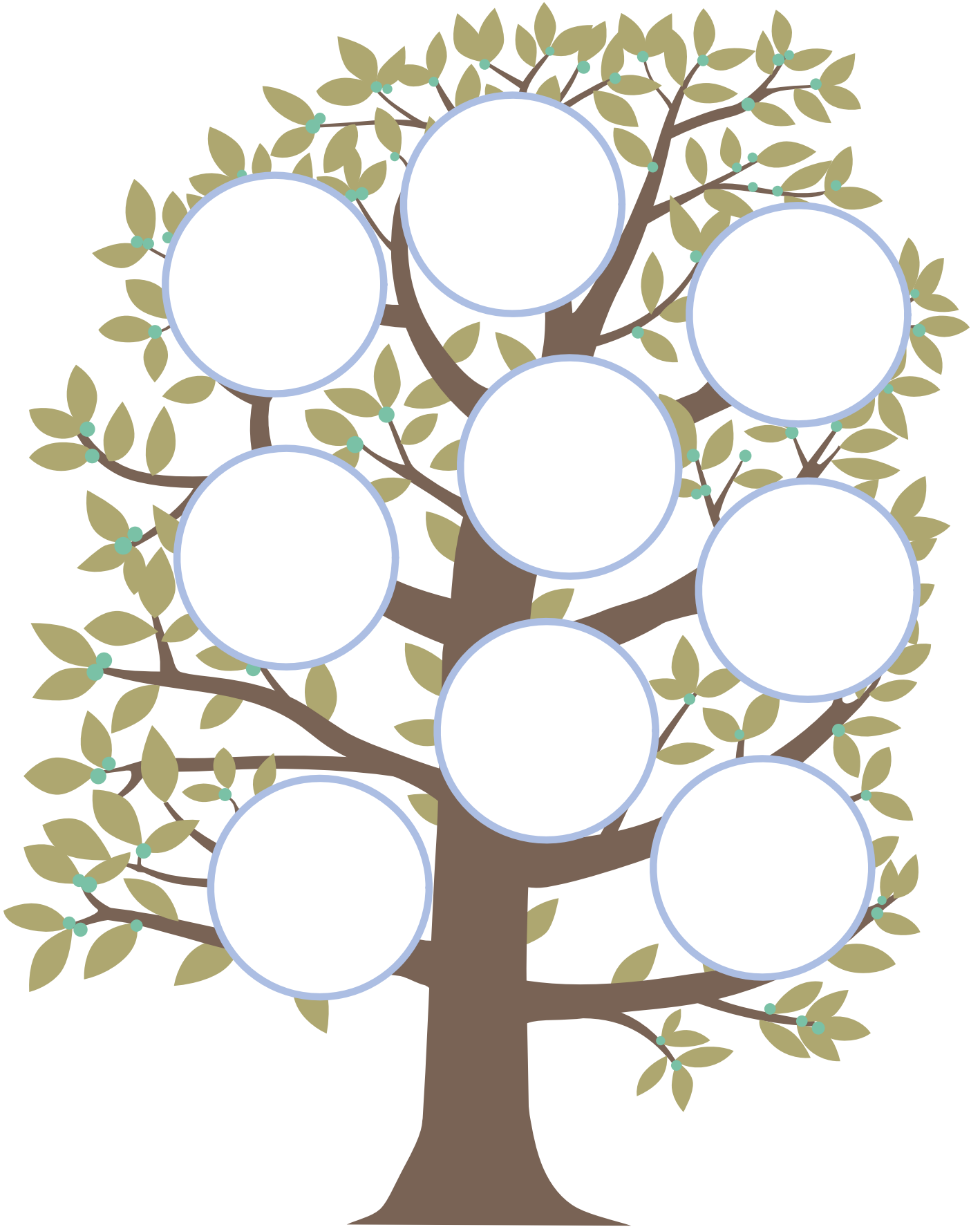
Korean artist Myoung Ho Lee began taking photographs of trees in 2004. Before he takes the photograph, he places a huge white canvas behind the tree so that the tree stands out. Myoung Ho Lee thinks of trees as being like a universe. He says trees 'unite all: the ground, the sky and the man in between'.
