TICKETING

Visitors need to purchase a ticket to attend *Cats* & *Dogs*. You can buy tickets:

- online via the Cats & Dogs webpage
- over the phone by calling (03) 8620 2222 between 9am and 5pm daily
- or in-person at the NGV

COMPANION AND CARER CARDS



If you have a Companion Card, you can receive a concession-priced ticket to *Cats & Dogs* for yourself and a complimentary ticket for your companion. Complimentary tickets for companions can be collected from the Gallery at the Information Desk.

Carer cardholders are also entitled to concession-priced tickets.

WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBILITY



Cats & Dogs is on display at The Ian Potter Centre: NGV Australia. The most accessible path to NGV Australia through Fed Square is via the Atrium from Flinders Street, or via the extension of Russell Street, which also has a car or taxi drop-off point.

The entrance to NGV Australia is on street level and has an automatic door.

The *Cats* & *Dogs* exhibition and all public areas in the NGV, including the cafe and NGV design store, are fully wheelchair accessible. There are accessible bathrooms on each level.

The exhibition is all on one level (Level 3) which can be reached via lift or stairs.

Wheelchairs are available for free hire from the Information Desk. We recommend booking a wheelchair prior to your visit by calling (03) 8620 2222 or making a booking online.

A motorised scooter is available for free hire. We recommend booking it prior to your visit by calling (03) 8620 2222 or emailing ngvenquiries@ngv.vic.gov.au

CHANGING PLACES BATHROOM



A Changing Places bathroom is located nearby at Arts Centre Melbourne's Hamer Hall, approximately 600 metres from NGV Australia. The most accessible path is through the Fed Square Atrium and along Flinders Street.

EXHIBITION CONTENT

The exhibition includes artworks featuring cats and dogs across different types of art including painting, prints, drawings, textiles, photography, sculpture, decorative arts and fashion.

The exhibition is appropriate for all ages.

Please note there are some depictions of dogs fighting each other and dogs biting people.

Some artworks feature nudity.

LAYOUT AND NAVIGATION

The exhibition is located on Level 3, which you can reach by lifts or stairs.

SENSORY ENVIRONMENT

Gallery spaces are air-conditioned, and are between 20 and 24 degrees Celsius.


